Honorable Chair Senator Lee Beyer and Committee Members,

I am writing to you today to ask you to please vote NO on HB4111

In research on election issues, I have been told by Department of Transportation that only citizens and people with legal presence are allowed to get any ID, Permit or License by DMV. I would disagree that DACA persons have current legal presence. The DACA order by President Obama which some consider unconstitutional was rescinded by President Trump. That is being held up in the courts. So the idea that these persons are legal is being debated in the court system. It is not assured.

Oregonians voted very strongly not to give any kind of permit, ID or Drivers license or card to persons who were not citizens or here legally in 2014 for measure 88. The bill was defeated by 66% of the vote. To give these persons legal cover on the above bases yet to be solved is to 'jump the gun' and will only further complicate our own DMV system.

Non-citizens in California are getting driver's cards and are being automatically registered to vote. Their government is not prosecuting them either. Their voter rolls are corrupted by foreign actors. Thus their elections are being tampered with by citizens of a different country. Our Legislature should be concerned about this failure to protect our elections. Are we doing the same thing?

I have been doing research on non-citizens on our voter rolls. <u>Non-citizens are getting on our voter rolls</u>. I have a list of foreign people from Multnomah County Elections that have been removed due to the fact that they are non-citizens. Did they have an opportunity to vote in an election before they were removed? I would be happy to share that list with the entire Oregon Legislature if necessary.

Can you assure me that no one with an Oregon Driver's card, permit or ID will not be able to register to vote online with that number? I understand they must check a box that says they are a citizen. If they lie and say they are a citizen, will the Document ID # stop them from using that tool? Is the system set up to recognize they are not a citizen? I don't believe it is.

The <u>automatic voter registration manual</u> excludes people who are previously registered to vote before the automatic voter registration process begins. See pages 4-7 of the linked document. Thus it is quite possible to be registered to vote via paper registration through a school registration process, or using the online voter registration tool and have a driver's license from DACA during Obama's presidency and be a Non-citizen.

Our social services administrative rules are funneling non-citizens into our voter rolls as well, by restricting any out of state ID from being submitted with their voter registration card.

We need an audit of the voter roll registration process in our state before we add more ways for someone to access our voter registration status by giving them Oregon ID.

Please stop this corruption, Vote No on HB4111.
