**Subject:** HB 4063 A – Relating to autonomous vehicles

Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 4063 designates the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) as the lead agency for autonomous vehicle programs and policies. It establishes a 26-member Task Force on Autonomous Vehicles, and requires the task force to develop recommendations for legislation to be submitted in a report no later than September 15, 2018. ODOT is required to provide staff support to the task force.

The -A8 amendment would add five members to the task force, increasing the membership from 26 to 31 members. Adds representation from a nonprofit entity, the commercial truck manufacturing industry, a consumer protection advocates, and a public university.

The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact.
