Subject: HB 4053 – Relating to accelerated college credit programs
Work Session Recommendations

The bill directs the Chief Education Office (CEdO), in collaboration with the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC), to prepare an annual report on accelerated college credit programs by December 1, 2018. After June 30, 2019 the HECC becomes the entity responsible for producing the report. The HECC must also adopt statewide standards for public post-secondary institutions of education to make information related to accelerated college credit programs available on each institution’s Internet website.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A7 amendment which contains a \$175,276 General Fund appropriation to the HECC in the 2017-19 biennium.
