Work Session Recommendation

The measure sets forth the policy of the state regarding the use of Good Neighbor Authority Agreements and provides a one-time allocation of \$500,000 Lottery Funds from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Department of Forestry to support projects on federal lands between state and federal agencies that are signatory to Good Neighbor Agreements.

The -A7 amendment replaces the Lottery Fund allocation in section 3 with a General Fund appropriation of \$500,000 for the same purpose.
