**Measure Description:**

Requires Oregon State Fire Marshal to issue grants to sheriffs' offices of Multnomah County and Hood River County for expenses related to wildfire recovery, mitigation and preparedness.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Counties, Oregon State Police (OSP)

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:**

**Analysis:**

The measure appropriates \$151,000 General Fund to the Oregon State Police State Fire Marshal to provide one-time grants to the sheriffs' offices of Multnomah County and Hood River County for certain wildfire expenses. The measure does not specify how much of the \$151,000 each county would receive. This amount of General Fund would be in addition to the costs of wildfire expenses already reimbursed to the counties by the Oregon State Fire Marshal.

The Oregon State Police assumes a minimal fiscal impact to essentially transfer the money to the respective counties for these non-competitive grants.
