Subject: SB 1565 – Relating to methods of public procurement

Work Session Recommendations

This bill creates two pilot programs relating to statewide procurement practices. One pilot will test "reverse auctions" and the other will test a 30 percent weighting requirement for price. The bill requires regular reporting on the progress of the pilots to the Governor and the Joint Committee on Information Technology.

The -A5 amendment removes the provisions in the bill that require the Department of Administrative Services, the Department of Transportation and the Department of Justice to designate an e-procurement vendor and write rules implementing an e-procurement system statewide.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A5 amendment.
