Work Session Recommendations

HB 4007 permits an individual to create a first-time home buyer savings account with financial institutions to pay or reimburse eligible costs for first time purchase of a single-family residence. The measure also increases the fee associated with recording of certain real property documents, from \$20 to \$60, and raises income limits for those who qualify for the Home Ownership Assistance Program.

Additional expenditure limitation is needed for the Housing and Community Services Department to make additional expenditures consisting of six additional positions (2.34 FTE) and \$15,973,153 Other Funds, for three separate housing programs supported by the document recording fee.
