Subject: HB 4089 – Relating to Industrial Hemp
Work Session Recommendations

HB 4089 establishes a pilot program within the Oregon Department of Agriculture, requires the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to track hemp and related items within the Cannabis Tracking system, and establishes a separate Industrial Hemp Fund within the Oregon Department of Agriculture. OLCC requires two additional positions to manage related work.

Additional Other Funds expenditure limitation of \$284,856 for OLCC is included in the -A9 amendment.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A9 amendment.
