Measure Description: Clarifies that a school district does not need to offer half-day kindergarten when it provides full-day kindergarten. Moves by two years to June 30, 2020, the sunset on provisions that allow foreign exchange students residing in a dormitory operated by an Oregon school district to be considered resident students of the school district in which the dormitory is located.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): This bill does not change the total formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts.

Impact Explanation: During the 2016-17 school year, there were 39 foreign exchange students living in Oregon school district-operated dormitories. Assuming the same number of such students in 2018-19, the estimated general purpose grant distribution to school districts with such students would total \$300,000.
