SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4137 Relating to addiction recovery

HB 4137 authorizes the director of the Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission to appoint employees to continue its work of developing and coordinating the implementation of a comprehensive addiction, prevention, treatment, and recovery plan for the state, with specific deadlines and reporting requirements.

The Oregon Health Authority estimates the fiscal impact of this bill to be \$46,202 General Fund, 1 position, and 0.17 FTE for the 2017-19 biennium; and \$892,081 General Fund, 5 positions, and 4 FTE for the 2019-21 biennium.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 4137 be amended by the –A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
