SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4163 Program Change

HB 4163, as amended, makes the necessary changes in statutes and session laws to support the 2017-19 legislatively adopted budget, to clarify the application of statutes for the budget, and to modify provisions relating to the use of funds. This non-appropriation bill is necessary to achieve a balanced budget for the 2017-19 biennium. Specifically, the measure:

- Moves responsibility for administering debt service on outstanding general obligation bonds sold for the benefit of Oregon Health and Science University from the Department of Administrative Services to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
- Moves civil penalties for recreational marijuana to the General Fund.
- Changes cost recovery requirement for financial institution data match.
- Provides for an actuarial review of the Public Employees Retirement System.
- Permits the Oregon Health Authority to designate another entity to be responsible for the cancer registry.
- Makes permanent current law changes to legislator salaries.
- Increases judges' annual salaries by \$5,000 on July 1, 2018.
- Moves Oregon Volunteers program from the Governor's Office to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
- Validates General Fund appropriation language for two agencies.

The bill has an emergency clause and is effective on passage.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 4163 be amended by the -1

amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
