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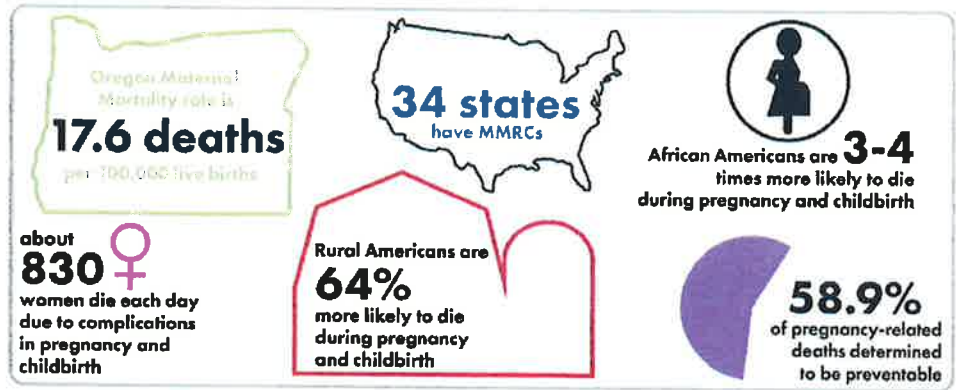

The United States is one of the few industrialized countries in which maternal death rates are rising; in contrast, rates have dramatically decreased globally in recent years. The causes of this disparity are not well known, but are likely related to social, economic, cultural, or medical issues, or a combination of factors. It is time for Oregon to take a stand and prevent maternal deaths. One woman dying from pregnancy-related death is one too many.



### HB 4133 B would:

- Establish a multi-disciplinary review panel consisting of local healthcare providers, public health experts, and culturally responsive community-based organizations, tasked with identifying, studying, and reviewing pregnancy-related death and severe morbidity
- Regular reporting and dissemination of findings with recommendations and protocols for policymakers, providers, and healthcare facilities on how to prevent future deaths and make pregnancies safer
