**Measure Description:**

Names certain scholarships offered by health care provider incentive program as Doctor Alan Bates Legacy Scholarship program.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

**Analysis:**

HB 4072 allocates \$1.5 million Lottery Funds from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Health Care Provider Incentive Fund to establish the Doctor Alan Bates Legacy Scholarship program as part of the Oregon Health Authority’s existing health care provider incentive program. The bill also removes extraneous language regarding the types of incentives that may be provided through the provider incentive program.

OHA will use the allocated funds to provide scholarships to students at institutions of higher education based in the state of Oregon who are enrolled in a health professional training program leading to a doctor of osteopathic medicine, doctor of dentistry, licensed nurse practitioner, physician assistant or a registered nurse anesthetist. OHA anticipates administering the Doctor Alan Bates Legacy Scholarship program using existing resources.
