**Measure Description:**

Directs Department of Environmental Quality and State Forestry Department to study opportunities for state actions to promote carbon sequestration and to include in study consideration of regional approaches for reducing greenhouse gas emissions through carbon sequestration.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Department of Forestry (ODF)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Forestry to jointly conduct a study of opportunities for state actions to promote carbon sequestration.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Environmental Quality and Department of Forestry.
