Measure Description:

Includes class size as mandatory subject of school district collective bargaining.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Employment Relations Board (ERB), School Districts

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate at this time - See explanatory analysis.

Analysis:

The ramifications of this measure cannot be fully estimated due to the unpredictable nature of collective bargaining; therefore, the fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time. The Employment Relations Board could be impacted by any increases in unfair labor practice complaints, strike notices, or mediation and training requests resulting from this legislation - this would increase staff workload and drive potential fiscal impacts to the Board. The bill does not make any changes to the State School Fund nor does it adjust the distribution formula used to calculate funds provided to school districts. Any increased costs to districts, resulting from this legislation, would be bargained for at the local level and would not necessarily be uniformly applicable to all school districts throughout the state.
