Measure Description:

Establishes Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund to protect, maintain, or enhance fish and wildlife resources in Oregon, and appropriates \$40,000 General Fund to support the fund.
