SUMMARY

Directs Health Licensing Office to issue residential care facility administrator license to qualified applicant. Requires individual currently employed as residential care facility administrator to obtain provisional license and pass examination on or before December 31, 2020. Renames "Nursing Home Administrators Board" as "Long Term Care Administrators Board."

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure adds residential care facility administrators to the definition of a health care provider. As a health care facility, patient information would fall under the definition of health information. Public records containing health information are exempt from public disclosure except under limited circumstances.

Records related to the health care of an individual are generally protected by federal and state law. It is unlikely that this type of record could be made subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law.
