SUMMARY

Requires Attorney General, Director of Oregon Department of Administrative Services and Director of Transportation to cooperate in adopting rules for electronic procurement system. Specifies minimum contents for rules. Requires state agency to use electronic procurement system in accordance with rules in conducting procurement. Permits contracting agency that is not state agency to use electronic procurement system in conducting procurement.

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to establish pilot program for using reverse auction method for conducting procurement for goods and services. Specifies features that pilot program must have. Requires department to evaluate pilot program and report results of evaluation to Governor and committee of Legislative Assembly related to procurement not later than December 31, 2019.

Requires state contracting agency in evaluating competitive proposal to weight proposed contract price at not less than 30 percent of total weight that state contracting agency gives to all factors in final evaluation of proposals. Provides that director or other head of state contracting agency may waive requirement if director or other head determines that waiver is in best interest of state contracting agency. Requires director or other head to report each waiver to Oregon Department of Administrative Services.

Becomes operative January 1, 2019.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.
