Measure Description:

Requires person, before creating, attaching, asserting or claiming lien on motor vehicle, to have in effect bond of not less than \$20,000 for purpose of paying owner of motor vehicle full amount of damages, costs, reimbursements or attorney fees owner obtains in action to obtain release or restored title to motor vehicle.
