- Members and Committees must submit drafting requests to the Office of Legislative Counsel no later than 5 p.m. on September 28, 2018.
- The Office of Legislative Counsel must deliver drafts of measures that are to be presession-filed no later than 5 p.m. on December 5, 2018.
- Requesters must submit drafts of measures to be presession-filed to the Senate Desk or House Desk no later than 5 p.m. on December 21, 2018.
- The President of the Senate, the House Interim Committee on Rules and the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means are not subject to these deadlines.
