

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4013

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 326.021 is amended to read:

3 “326.021. (1) The State Board of Education shall consist of:

4 “(a) The State Treasurer, or [*the designee*] **a person employed on a full-time basis in the of-**
5 **fice** of the State Treasurer;

6 “(b) The Secretary of State, or [*the designee*] **a person employed on a full-time basis in the**
7 **office** of the Secretary of State; and

8 “(c) Seven members, appointed by the Governor for a term of four years beginning July 1 of the
9 year of appointment, subject to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562
10 and 171.565. A person appointed under this paragraph may not be appointed to serve consecutively
11 more than two full terms as a board member.

12 “(2) In making appointments under subsection (1)(c) of this section, the Governor shall select
13 from residents of Oregon one member from each congressional district and two members from the
14 state at large. An appointed member may not be engaged in teaching or participate in the adminis-
15 tration or operation of any school.

16 “(3) The Governor may remove appointed members of the State Board of Education for cause
17 at any time after notice and public hearing.

18 “(4) The State Treasurer and the Secretary of State, or the [*designee of the State Treasurer or*
19 *Secretary of State*] **employee in the office of the State Treasurer or Secretary of State**, are
20 nonvoting, ex officio members of the board.

21 “(5) The board shall coordinate and collaborate with the Chief Education Office as provided by
22 section 1, chapter 519, Oregon Laws 2011.

23 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 326.021, as amended by section 42, chapter 774, Oregon Laws 2015, is
24 amended to read:

25 “326.021. (1) The State Board of Education shall consist of:

26 “(a) The State Treasurer, or [*the designee*] **a person employed on a full-time basis in the of-**
27 **fice** of the State Treasurer;

28 “(b) The Secretary of State, or [*the designee*] **a person employed on a full-time basis in the**
29 **office** of the Secretary of State; and

30 “(c) Seven members, appointed by the Governor for a term of four years beginning July 1 of the
31 year of appointment, subject to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562
32 and 171.565. A person appointed under this paragraph may not be appointed to serve consecutively
33 more than two full terms as a board member.

34 “(2) In making appointments under subsection (1)(c) of this section, the Governor shall select
35 from residents of Oregon one member from each congressional district and two members from the

1 state at large. An appointed member may not be engaged in teaching or participate in the adminis-

3 “(3) The Governor may remove appointed members of the State Board of Education for cause

5 “(4) The State Treasurer and the Secretary of State, or the [*designee of the State Treasurer or*
6 *Secretary of State*] **employee in the office of the State Treasurer or Secretary of State**, are
7 nonvoting, ex officio members of the board.

8 “**SECTION 3. This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.”.**
