SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Secretary of State to conduct study and analyze implementation of laws relating to elections that were passed during 2017 regular session of Legislative Assembly. Requires secretary to develop recommendations regarding most effective methods for improving implementation of laws. Requires secretary to submit report to interim legislative committees detailing recommendations by October 1, 2019.

Sunsets January 2, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to elections.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct a study and analyze the implementation of laws relating to elections that were passed during the 2017 regular session of the Legislative Assembly. As part of the study, the secretary shall develop recommendations, which may include recommendations for additional legislation, regarding the most effective methods for improving implementation of the laws.
 - (2) The secretary shall submit a report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, including the recommendations made under subsection (1) of this section, to the interim legislative committees on rules no later than October 1, 2019.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2018 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.
