## House Bill 4077

Sponsored by Representatives RAYFIELD, KENY-GUYER; Representatives GOMBERG, HERNANDEZ, NOSSE, SANCHEZ, SOLLMAN, WITT, Senator FREDERICK (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires statement of economic interest to include certain information about sources of income for business in which public official or candidate, or member of household of public official or candidate, is officer or holds directorship if source of income has legislative or administrative interest and 10 percent or more of total gross annual income of business comes from that source of income.

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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to contents of statements of economic interest; creating new provisions; and amending ORS
 244.060.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 244.060 is amended to read:

6 244.060. The statement of economic interest filed under ORS 244.050 shall be on a form pre-7 scribed by the Oregon Government Ethics Commission. The public official or candidate filing the 8 statement shall supply the information required by this section and ORS 244.090, as follows:

9 (1) The names of all positions as officer of a business and business directorships held by the 10 public official or candidate or a member of the household of the public official or candidate during 11 the preceding calendar year, and the principal address and a brief description of each business.

(2) All names under which the public official or candidate and members of the household of the
public official or candidate do business and the principal address and a brief description of each
business.

(3) The names, principal addresses and brief descriptions of the sources of income received during the preceding calendar year by the public official or candidate or a member of the household of the public official or candidate that produce 10 percent or more of the total annual household income.

(4)(a) A list of all real property in which the public official or candidate or a member of the household of the public official or candidate has or has had any personal, beneficial ownership interest during the preceding calendar year, any options to purchase or sell real property, including a land sales contract, and any other rights of any kind in real property located within the geographic boundaries of the governmental agency of which the public official holds, or the candidate if elected would hold, an official position or over which the public official exercises, or the candidate if elected would exercise, any authority.

(b) This subsection does not require the listing of the principal residence of the public officialor candidate.

(5) All expenses with an aggregate value exceeding \$50 received by the public official during the
 preceding calendar year when participating in a convention, mission, trip or other meeting described
 in ORS 244.020 (7)(b)(F), including the name and address of the organization, unit of government,

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1 tribe or corporation paying the expenses, the nature of the event and the date and amount of the 2 expense.

(6) All expenses with an aggregate value exceeding \$50 received by the public official during the
preceding calendar year when participating in a mission, negotiations or economic development activities described in ORS 244.020 (7)(b)(H), including the name and address of the person paying the
expenses, the nature of the event and the date and amount of the expenditure.

7 (7) All honoraria and other items allowed under ORS 244.042 with a value exceeding \$15 that 8 are received by the public official, candidate or member of the household of the public official or 9 candidate during the preceding calendar year, the provider of each honorarium or item and the date 10 and time of the event for which the honorarium or item was received.

(8) The name, principal address and brief description of each source of income exceeding an 11 12aggregate amount of \$1,000, whether or not taxable, received by the public official or candidate, or 13 a member of the household of the public official or candidate, during the preceding calendar year, if the source of that income is derived from an individual or business that has a legislative or ad-14 15 ministrative interest or that has been doing business, does business or could reasonably be expected to do business with the governmental agency of which the public official holds, or the candidate if 16 elected would hold, an official position or over which the public official exercises, or the candidate 17 18 if elected would exercise, any authority.

(9)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the names, principal ad dresses and brief descriptions of sources of income received during the preceding calendar
 year by a business identified under subsection (1) of this section if:

(A) The source of income has a legislative or administrative interest or has been doing business, does business or could reasonably be expected to do business with the governmental agency of which the public official holds, or the candidate if elected would hold, an official position or over which the public official exercises, or the candidate if elected would exercise, any authority; and

(B) Ten percent or more of the total gross annual income of the business identified under
subsection (1) of this section comes from the source of income.

(b) This subsection does not require the public official or candidate filing the statement
 to supply information that the public official or candidate has a statutory duty to keep
 privileged or confidential.

32 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 244.060 by section 1 of this 2018 Act apply to 33 statements of economic interest filed on or after the effective date of this 2018 Act.

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
