SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Department of Human Services to use savings in temporary assistance for needy families program to increase amount of cash grants.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the temporary assistance for needy families program; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Beginning July 1, 2018, if policy changes made by the Department of Human
- 5 Services in the temporary assistance for needy families program, an improvement in the
- 6 economy of this state or other factors result in savings in the program, the department shall
- 7 use the savings to increase the amount of the cash grants provided through the program up
- 8 to an amount equal to the value of the grants in 1996, adjusted to reflect increases in U.S.
- 9 City Average Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (All Items) as published by the
- 10 Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.
 - SECTION 2. This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
- peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect on its passage.
