## House Bill 4096

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Chief Justice Thomas A. Balmer for Judicial Department, Oregon Circuit Court Judges Association)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Modifies annual salaries of judges of Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court and circuit courts.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to judicial salaries; amending ORS 292.406, 292.411, 292.416 and 292.426; and prescribing an effective date.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 292.406 is amended to read:
- 6 292.406. (1)(a) The annual salary of the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals shall be [\$135,688
- 7 for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and for each year thereafter] \$147,560 for the period begin-
- 8 ning on January 1, 2017, and ending on June 30, 2018.
- 9 (b) On [January 1, 2017,] July 1, 2018, and January 1 of 2019 and 2020, the annual salary of the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, as adjusted under ORS 292.428, shall be increased by [\$5,000] \$6,372.
  - (2)(a) The annual salary of each other judge of the Court of Appeals shall be [\$132,820 for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and for each year thereafter] \$144,536 for the period beginning on January 1, 2017, and ending on June 30, 2018.
  - (b) On [January 1, 2017,] July 1, 2018, and January 1 of 2019 and 2020, the annual salary of each other judge of the Court of Appeals, as adjusted under ORS 292.428, shall be increased by [\$5,000] \$6,348.
    - SECTION 2. ORS 292.411 is amended to read:
  - 292.411. (1)(a) The annual salary of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall be [\$138,556 for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and for each year thereafter] \$150,572 for the period beginning on January 1, 2017, and ending on June 30, 2018.
  - (b) On [January 1, 2017,] July 1, 2018, and January 1 of 2019 and 2020, the annual salary of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, as adjusted under ORS 292.428, shall be increased by [\$5,000] \$5,976.
  - (2)(a) The annual salary of each other judge of the Supreme Court shall be [\$135,688 for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and for each year thereafter] \$147,560 for the period beginning on January 1, 2017, and ending on June 30, 2018.
  - (b) On [January 1, 2017,] July 1, 2018, and January 1 of 2019 and 2020, the annual salary of each other judge of the Supreme Court, as adjusted under ORS 292.428, shall be increased by [\$5,000] \$6,372.
