

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4111

By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “amending ORS 807.460” and insert “creating new provisions;
2 amending ORS 807.460; and declaring an emergency”.

3 After line 21, insert:

4 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2018 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle
5 Code.**

6 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 807.021 and 807.730, a person is not required to
7 provide proof of legal presence in the United States when applying for a limited term iden-
8 tification card, a limited term driver license or a limited term driver permit if:**

9 **“(a) The Department of Transportation previously issued a limited term identification
10 card, a limited term driver license or a limited term driver permit to the applicant;**

11 **“(b) The applicant presents to the department an Employment Authorization Document
12 issued by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services under category C33, A12
13 or C19; and**

14 **“(c) The applicant’s Employment Authorization Document expired on or after August 1,
15 2014.**

16 **“(2) Notwithstanding ORS 807.022, the department may not verify the documents de-
17 scribed in this section.**

18 **“(3) Notwithstanding ORS 807.130, a limited term driver license issued or renewed under
19 this section expires two years from the date of issuance.**

20 **“SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2018 Act is repealed on December 31, 2021.**

21 **“SECTION 5. Section 3 of this 2018 Act applies to limited term identification cards, lim-
22 ited term driver licenses and limited term driver permits issued, renewed or replaced on or
23 after July 1, 2018.**

24 **“SECTION 6. (1) The amendments to ORS 807.460 by section 1 of this 2018 Act become
25 operative on January 1, 2019.**

26 **“(2) Section 3 of this 2018 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2018.**

27 **“(3) The Department of Transportation may take any action before the operative dates
28 specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section that is necessary to enable the department
29 to exercise, on and after the operative dates specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this sec-
30 tion, all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 3 of this
31 2018 Act and the amendments to ORS 807.460 by section 1 of this 2018 Act.**

32 **“SECTION 7. This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
33 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect
34 on its passage.”.**
