

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4141

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 9, after “regarding” insert “resident”.
- 2 On page 2, line 9, delete “receive” and insert “are offered”.
- 3 In line 14, after “of” insert “resident”.
- 4 In line 21, after “how” insert “resident” and delete “will” and insert “could”.
- 5 Delete lines 23 through 28 and insert:
- 6 “(5) Before making a recommendation to the president of the university that resident tuition and
- 7 mandatory enrollment fees should be increased by more than five percent annually, the advisory
- 8 body must document its consideration of:
- 9 “(a) The impact of the resident tuition and mandatory enrollment fees that the advisory body
- 10 intends to recommend to the president of the public university on:
- 11 “(A) Students at the public university, with an emphasis on historically underserved students,
- 12 as defined by the public university; and
- 13 “(B) The mission of the public university, as described by the mission statement adopted under
- 14 ORS 352.089; and”.
- 15 In line 29, after “in” insert “resident”.
- 16 In line 38, after “regarding” insert “resident”.
- 17 In line 42, after “establishing” insert “resident”.
- 18 On page 3, after line 3, insert:
- 19 “(8) As used in this section, ‘resident tuition and mandatory enrollment fees’ means the tuition
- 20 and mandatory enrollment fees for undergraduate students who are enrolled in a degree program
- 21 and have established residency in Oregon.”.
