<u>SECTION 7.</u> For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a fingerprint-based background check fee of \$40, adopted by the Occupational Therapy Licensing Board and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

SECTION 8. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a Cannabis Tracking System user fee of \$480 for the Oregon Medical Marijuana Program, adopted by the Oregon Health Authority and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

<u>SECTION 9.</u> For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

<u>SECTION 10.</u> This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect on its passage.
