**House Concurrent Resolution 205**

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rules for Representative Caddy McKeown)

Whereas Private First Class Brice M. Scott was born on September 17, 1988, in Eugene, Oregon; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott attended North Eugene High School and was awarded a General Educational Development certificate; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott enlisted in the United States Army in March 2010, joining a long line of family members who had served in the military; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott was assigned to the 4th Squadron, 4th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Heavy Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division, based at Fort Riley, Kansas; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott was a 19D Cavalry Scout and belt-fed machine gunner; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott deployed to Afghanistan in February 2011; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott and two other soldiers were working on a security checkpoint in Kandahar Province, Afghanistan, when they were ambushed by eight insurgents; and

Whereas on July 31, 2011, Private First Class Scott succumbed to wounds sustained from enemy small arms fire while trying to help one of his fellow soldiers; and

Whereas family members of Private First Class Scott said that he always tried to help others and put their needs before his own; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott was honored with a military service in Florence, Oregon, where a United States Coast Guard helicopter did a fly-by and flags lined the streets; and

Whereas Private First Class Scott was also honored in a service at Fort Riley, where his wife and two young daughters were living; and

Whereas the Legislative Assembly wishes to honor the sacrifices of Private First Class Scott in support of Operation Enduring Freedom; now, therefore,

**Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

That we, the members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Private First Class Brice M. Scott for his service to his country.
