Senate Bill 1532

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies definition of "motor assisted scooter" for purposes of Oregon Vehicle Code.

2	Relating to motor assisted scooters; amending ORS 801.348.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 801.348 is amended to read:
5	801.348. "Motor assisted scooter" means a vehicle that:
6	(1) Is designed to be operated on the ground with not more than [three] four wheels;
7	(2) Has handlebars and a foot support or seat for the operator's use;
8	(3) Can be propelled by motor or human propulsion; and
9	(4) Is equipped with a power source that is incapable of propelling the vehicle at a speed of
10	greater than 24 miles per hour on level ground and:
11	(a) If the power source is a combustion engine, has a piston or rotor displacement of 35 cubic
12	centimeters or less regardless of the number of chambers in the power source; or
13	(b) If the power source is electric, has a power output of not more than 1,000 watts.
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
