

Senate Bill 1546

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Chief Justice Thomas A. Balmer for Judicial Department)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows creditable service performed by judge member of Public Employees Retirement System to count toward hours of service required for vesting in pension program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to judges; creating new provisions; amending ORS 238A.115; and prescribing an effective
3 date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 238A.115 is amended to read:

6 238A.115. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a member of the pension pro-
7 gram becomes vested in the pension program on the earliest of the following dates:

8 (a) The date on which the member completes at least 600 hours of service in each of five cal-
9 endar years. The five calendar years need not be consecutive, but are subject to the provisions of
10 subsection (3) of this section.

11 (b) The date on which an active member reaches the normal retirement age for the member
12 under ORS 238A.160.

13 (c) If the pension program is terminated, the date on which termination becomes effective, but
14 only to the extent the pension program is then funded.

15 (2) If on the date that a person becomes an active member the person has already reached the
16 normal retirement age for the person under ORS 238A.160, the person is vested in the pension pro-
17 gram on that date.

18 (3) If a member of the pension program who is not vested in the pension program performs fewer
19 than 600 hours of service in each of five consecutive calendar years, hours of service performed
20 before the first calendar year of the period of five consecutive calendar years shall be disregarded
21 for purposes of determining whether the member is vested under subsection (1)(a) of this section.

22 (4) Solely for purposes of determining whether a member is vested under this section, hours of
23 service include creditable service, as defined in ORS 238.005, performed by [*the person before the*
24 *person became an eligible employee*] **a judge member**, as long as the membership of the person under
25 ORS chapter 238 has not been terminated under the provisions of **ORS 238.545** [*ORS 238.095 on the*
26 *date the person becomes an eligible employee*].

27 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 238A.115 by section 1 of this 2018 Act apply only
28 to a member of the pension program of the Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan whose
29 effective date of retirement as a judge member of the Public Employees Retirement System

1 under ORS 238.500 to 238.585 is on or after January 1, 2018.

2 SECTION 3. This 2018 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2018
3 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
