

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1550

1 Delete lines 4 through 28 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2018 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 506.**

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) In addition to any other authority under the commercial fishing laws,**  
4 **and except as provided in this subsection, the State Fish and Wildlife Commission may adopt**  
5 **record keeping requirements for a person that engages in taking, landing, buying or selling**  
6 **food fish for commercial purposes or otherwise deals in food fish for commercial purposes.**  
7 **Records that the commission may require under this section include, but need not be limited**  
8 **to, records sufficient to show the source and disposition of food fish and any other informa-**  
9 **tion the commission deems necessary for tracing the chain of possession for food fish. The**  
10 **commission may not make record keeping requirements under this section applicable to**  
11 **tribal members exercising the treaty-reserved rights of an Indian tribe.**

12 **“(2) A person that the commission makes subject to a record keeping requirement under**  
13 **this section shall make the records available for inspection by the commission, the State**  
14 **Department of Fish and Wildlife or the State Department of Agriculture, or by a designee**  
15 **of the commission, State Department of Fish and Wildlife or State Department of Agricul-**  
16 **ture. The State Department of Agriculture may request copies of, or information from, the**  
17 **records for the purpose of programs under ORS chapter 616 or other food safety law pro-**  
18 **grams administered or enforced by the department. The State Department of Agriculture**  
19 **may, as part of a general pattern of administering and enforcing programs under ORS**  
20 **chapter 616 or other food safety law programs, during normal business hours enter premises**  
21 **where records described in this section are kept.**

22 **“(3) A person may keep records required by the commission under this section in elec-**  
23 **tronic form and may satisfy a request for inspection of the records by supplying a copy of**  
24 **the records in electronic form to the requester. If the records are not supplied to the re-**  
25 **quester in electronic form, the person shall allow inspection of the records upon request**  
26 **during normal business hours.”.**
