Senate Bill 5701

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Increases limit for six-year period beginning July 1, 2017, on payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal

funds, collected or received by Department of Corrections for capital construction.

Limits, for six-year period beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures from federal funds collected or received by Oregon Military Department for capital construction.

Increases limits for six-year period beginning July 1, 2015, on payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Military Department and Oregon Department of Aviation for capital construction.

Increases limits, for six-year period beginning July 1, 2015, on expenditures from federal funds collected or received by Oregon Department of Aviation for capital construction.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1

Relating to state financial administration; amending sections 1 and 2, chapter 808, Oregon Laws 2015, and sections 1 and 2, chapter 747, Oregon Laws 2017; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
