**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4103**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 8 through 25 and insert:

2 “(2) Shall allow a contracted pharmacy the option to mail or deliver pre-
3 scription drugs to its patients;

4 “(3) May not require a patient signature as proof of delivery of a mailed
5 or delivered prescription drug if the pharmacy maintains a mail or delivery
6 log signed by a representative of the pharmacy or has delivery documenta-
7 tion by the United States Postal Service or a commercial delivery service;

8 “(4) May not require a licensed pharmacist or a retail pharmacy, as a
9 condition of payment, reimbursement or contracting with the pharmacy ben-
10 efit manager, to meet accreditation, certification or credentialing standards
11 in addition to those required by the State Board of Pharmacy or other state
12 or federal laws. This subsection does not prevent a pharmacy benefit man-
13 ager from denying reimbursement of a claim for a specialty drug if the
14 pharmacist or pharmacy does not have the training, facilities or systems in
15 place to meet the state dispensing requirements for the drug; and

16 “(5) Shall notify any person whose pharmacy benefits are administered
17 by the pharmacy benefit manager of any financial or ownership interests that
18 exist between the”.

19 On page 2, after line 25, insert:

20 “(9) ‘Specialty drug’ means a drug:

21 “(a) That requires difficult or unusual:

1 “(A) Preparation;
2 “(B) Handling;
3 “(C) Storage;
4 “(D) Inventory; or
5 “(E) Distribution;
6 “(b) That has difficult or unusual data collection or administrative re-
7 quirements associated with it;
8 “(c) For which the United States Food and Drug Administration requires
9 a Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategy; or
10 “(d) That requires patient management by a pharmacist, prior to or after
11 the dispensing of the drug, in the form of:
12 “(A) Monitoring; or
13 “(B) Disease or therapeutic support systems.”.
14 In line 26, delete “(9)” and insert “(10)”.
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
