**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4152**

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The operator of a public campground may not en-**  
3 **force a limit on the duration of a stay in the public campground**  
4 **against an individual or a member of the individual’s immediate fam-**  
5 **ily if:**

6 **“(a) The individual has, within the preceding 24 hours, engaged in**  
7 **work related to suppression of wildfire; and**

8 **“(b) The individual displays an unexpired incident qualification**  
9 **card.**

10 **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits an operator of a public**  
11 **campground from enforcing rules or regulations unrelated to limits**  
12 **on the duration of a stay.**

13 **“(3) As used in this section:**

14 **“(a) ‘Incident qualification card’ means a certification of qualifica-**  
15 **tion to perform work related to fire suppression that is issued in co-**  
16 **ordination with, and according to standards established by, a national**  
17 **wildfire coordinating group.**

18 **“(b) ‘Public campground’ means a site owned or operated by a unit**  
19 **of state or local government that is made available to the general**  
20 **public for overnight camping.**

21 **“(c) ‘Wildfire’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 477.089.**
