**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4127**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest
2 of the line and line 3 and insert “and prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Qualifications-Based Selection**
5 **is established.**

6 **“(2) The task force consists of seven members appointed as follows:**

7 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members from**
8 **among members of the Senate.**

9 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two**
10 **members from among members of the House of Representatives.**

11 **“(c) The Governor shall appoint:**

12 **“(A) One member that represents state contracting agencies.**

13 **“(B) One member that represents local contracting agencies.**

14 **“(C) One member that represents consultants that have provided**
15 **architectural, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation**
16 **planning or land surveying services to contracting agencies in this**
17 **state.**

18 **“(3) The task force shall consider qualifications-based selection**
19 **procedures set forth in ORS 279C.100 to 279C.125 and recommend in a**
20 **report any changes to the procedures that the task force determines**
21 **are necessary to accommodate the interests of state and local con-**

1 **tracting agencies and the business needs of consultants that provide**
2 **architectural, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation**
3 **planning and land surveying services to the contracting agencies.**

4 **“(4) The task force may consult experts, take testimony, conduct**
5 **research, prepare reports and other materials, investigate best prac-**
6 **tices in other states or jurisdictions and otherwise perform any other**
7 **task that is necessary to carry out the purposes set forth in subsection**
8 **(3) of this section.**

9 **“(5) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a**
10 **quorum for the transaction of business.**

11 **“(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**
12 **majority of the members of the task force.**

13 **“(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**
14 **chairperson.**

15 **“(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**
16 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

17 **“(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**
18 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the task**
19 **force.**

20 **“(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation**
21 **of the task force.**

22 **“(11) The task force shall submit the report required by this section**
23 **in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommen-**
24 **dations for legislation, to an interim committee of the Legislative As-**
25 **sembly related to public procurement no later than September 15, 2019.**

26 **“(12) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall pro-**
27 **vide staff support to the task force.**

28 **“(13) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**
29 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement**
30 **for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

1 “(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,
2 are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the task
3 force’s duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to
4 confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the
5 task force consider necessary to perform their duties.

6 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2018 Act is repealed on December 31,
7 2019.

8 “SECTION 3. This 2018 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
9 date on which the 2018 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
10 Assembly adjourns sine die.”

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
