**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4120**

1 On page 4 of the printed bill, delete lines 38 through 43 and insert:

2 “(5)(a) A unit of local government that imposes a local transient lodging  
3 tax may, in conformity with the charter, ordinances, resolutions and admin-  
4 istrative rules of the unit of local government and all applicable federal and  
5 state law, subpoena and examine witnesses, administer oaths and order the  
6 production of any books or papers in the hands of any person, whenever the  
7 unit of local government deems such action necessary and proper in the  
8 prosecution of inquiries related to the local transient lodging tax. Informa-  
9 tion requested of a transient lodging tax collector that is subject to Title II  
10 of the Electronic Communications Privacy Act of 1986, 18 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.,  
11 is limited by the provisions of that title.

12 “(b) A unit of local government may enforce a subpoena or order for  
13 production of books or papers issued pursuant to paragraph (a) of this sub-  
14 section under the laws of the unit of local government.”.
