**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4060**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after “184.758,” insert “184.761,”.

2 On page 21, after line 19, insert:

3 **“SECTION 24a.** ORS 184.761 is amended to read:

4 “184.761. (1) The governing body of each qualified entity shall appoint an
5 advisory committee to advise and assist the governing body in prioritizing
6 plans or projects to be funded from the moneys received from a percentage
7 distribution under ORS 184.758 to public transportation service providers
8 that provide services within the jurisdiction of the qualified entity.

9 “(2) Before receiving funding for a project under ORS 184.758, a public
10 transportation service provider that provides services within the jurisdiction
11 of a qualified entity shall submit a plan or project proposal to the governing
12 body of the qualified entity and receive the advisory committee’s approval
13 of the plan or project proposal. The plans or project proposals submitted
14 under this subsection must describe how the funds would be used.

15 “(3) An advisory committee appointed under this section shall review ev-
16 ery plan or project proposal required under subsection (2) of this section and
17 may propose any changes to the policies or practices of the governing body
18 that the advisory committee considers necessary to ensure that:

19 “(a) A public transportation service provider that has received funding
20 under ORS 184.758 has applied the moneys received in accordance with and
21 for the purposes described in the provider’s plan or project proposal; and

1 “(b) A plan or project proposal submitted by a public transportation ser-
2 vice provider does not fragment the provision of public transportation ser-
3 vices.

4 “(4) The Oregon Transportation Commission shall adopt by rule:

5 “(a) Requirements for the composition of an advisory committee appointed
6 under this section;

7 “(b) Criteria that must be included in a plan or project proposal required
8 under subsection (2) of this section; and

9 “(c) A process by which an advisory committee shall review and approve
10 a plan or project proposal.

11 **“(5) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the governing**
12 **bodies of two or more qualified entities may appoint advisory com-**
13 **mittee members to a joint advisory committee under conditions de-**
14 **termined by the commission by rule.”.**
