**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4020**

1 On page 20 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 11, insert:

5 **“SECTION 21. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
6 **General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by**
7 **section 1 (1), chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium ending**
8 **June 30, 2019, for programs, is increased by \$245,991 for the purpose**
9 **of carrying out the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this 2018 Act.**

10 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-**
11 **tation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 545, Oregon**
12 **Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, as the maximum**
13 **limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,**
14 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts, recreational**
15 **marijuana tax receipts, provider taxes, Medicare receipts and federal**
16 **funds for indirect cost recovery, Supplemental Security Income re-**
17 **coveries, Women, Infants and Children Program food rebates, the Co-**
18 **ordinated School Health Program, the Edward Byrne Memorial State**
19 **and Local Law Enforcement Assistance Grant Program and emergency**
20 **preparedness and response services, but excluding lottery funds and**
21 **federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2017,**

1 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for programs,
2 is increased by \$106,583 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions
3 of sections 2 and 3 of this 2018 Act.

4 “(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
5 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter 545, Oregon
6 Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, as the maximum
7 limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
8 including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts, recreational
9 marijuana tax receipts, provider taxes, Medicare receipts and federal
10 funds for indirect cost recovery, Supplemental Security Income re-
11 coveries, Women, Infants and Children Program food rebates, the Co-
12 ordinated School Health Program, the Edward Byrne Memorial State
13 and Local Law Enforcement Assistance Grant Program and emergency
14 preparedness and response services, but excluding lottery funds and
15 federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2017,
16 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for shared ad-
17 ministrative services, is increased by \$100,045 for the purpose of car-
18 rying out the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this 2018 Act.

19 “(4) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
20 tation on expenditures established by section 4 (1), chapter 545, Oregon
21 Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, as the maximum
22 limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding federal
23 funds described in section 2, chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2017, collected
24 or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for programs, is increased
25 by \$45,946 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of sections 2
26 and 3 of this 2018 Act.”.
