- "SECTION 14. (1) A person commits the crime of threatening to commit a terroristic act if:
- 6 "(a) The person subjects another to fear or terror by conveying a 7 threat to cause a mass casualty event;
- 8 "(b) The person expresses the intent to carry out the threat; and
- 9 "(c) A reasonable person would:
- 10 "(A) Be placed in fear or terror by the threat; and
- 11 "(B) Believe that the threat was likely to be carried out.
- "(2) Threatening to commit a terroristic act is a Class C felony.
- "(3) As used in this section, 'mass casualty event' means a violent act that results in extraordinary levels of death or physical injury to other persons.".

- In line 32, delete "14" and insert "16".
