**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1543**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, after the semicolon de-
2 lete the rest of the line and line 4 and insert “and declaring an
3 emergency.”.

4 On page 18, delete lines 30 through 32 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 13. (1) Jurisdiction is conferred upon the Supreme Court
6 to determine whether chapter 673, Oregon Laws 2017, violates any
7 provision of the Oregon Constitution, for the following appeals:**

8 **“(a) In a civil action, any appeal in which the notice of appeal was
9 filed after January 1, 2018, and before April 1, 2018; or**

10 **“(b) In an appeal by a criminal defendant, any appeal in which:**

11 **“(A) The only assignment of error relates to the constitutionality
12 of a section of chapter 673, Oregon Laws 2017;**

13 **“(B) A notice of appeal was filed after January 1, 2018, and before
14 April 1, 2018; and**

15 **“(C) The defendant requests in writing, no later than April 13, 2018,
16 that the appeal be decided by the Supreme Court.**

17 **“(2) The Supreme Court shall, to the extent practicable, expedite its
18 disposition of appeals under subsection (1)(a) of this section as pro-
19 vided in the rules of appellate procedure.**

20 **“SECTION 14. Section 13 of this 2018 Act is repealed on July 1, 2023.**

21 **“SECTION 15. The amendments to ORS 423.105 by section 8 of this**

1 **2018 Act become operative on June 30, 2018.**

2 **“SECTION 16. The amendments to ORS 137.540, 162.375 and 837.365**
3 **by sections 6, 9 and 10 of this 2018 Act apply to offenses committed on**
4 **or after the effective date of this 2018 Act.**

5 **“SECTION 17. This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate**
6 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
7 **declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
