**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5703**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “7 and 8” and insert “3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 10,
2 13, 17, 20 and 23”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to
5 read:

6 **“Sec. 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning
7 July 1, 2017, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund,
8 to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:

20 **“Sec. 4.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from
21 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Department

1 of Education, for the State School Fund, the amount of [~~\$464,758,594~~
2 **\$535,719,907**.

3 **“SECTION 3.** Section 6, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to
4 read:

5 **“Sec. 6.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from
6 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the office of the
7 Governor, the amount of [~~\$3,689,100~~] **\$3,723,949** for expenses of the Regional
8 Solutions Program.

9 **“SECTION 4.** Section 7, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to
10 read:

11 **“Sec. 7.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall es-
12 tablish a process for allocating available moneys in the Administrative Ser-
13 vices Economic Development Fund on a quarterly basis to fulfill the biennial
14 allocations made by sections 1 to [~~12 of this 2017 Act~~] **12a, chapter 598,**
15 **Oregon Laws 2017.** The department shall set the quarterly allocations.

16 “(2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the State Lottery
17 Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund are insuf-
18 ficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by sections 1 to [~~12 of this~~
19 ~~2017 Act or any other 2017 Act~~] **12a, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017,** prior
20 to making any other allocations pursuant to sections 1 to [~~12 of this 2017~~
21 ~~Act~~] **12a, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017,** the department shall satisfy lot-
22 tery bond debt service obligations in the amount of [~~\$247,787,311~~]
23 **\$246,357,867** for outstanding lottery bonds.

24 “(3) After the lottery bond debt service obligations described in subsection
25 (2) of this section are satisfied, if the remaining moneys transferred from the
26 State Lottery Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Development
27 Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by sections
28 1 to [~~12 of this 2017 Act~~] **12a, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017,** the depart-
29 ment shall reduce the quarterly allocations not described in subsection (2)
30 of this section proportionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the

1 revenue shortfall.

2 **“SECTION 5.** Section 8, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to
3 read:

4 **“Sec. 8.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from
5 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon
6 Department of Administrative Services, the amount of [*\$247,787,311*]
7 **\$246,357,867** for the purpose of paying, when due, the principal, interest and
8 premium, if any, on outstanding lottery bonds, as described in section 7 [*of*
9 *this 2017 Act*], **chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, as amended by section 4**
10 **of this 2018 Act.**

11 **“SECTION 6.** Section 10, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to
12 read:

13 **“Sec. 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549
14 (2) for a percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning
15 July 1, 2017, the amount allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
16 nomic Development Fund to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund is
17 [*\$12,457,116*] **\$12,498,909.**

18 **“SECTION 7.** Section 13, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to
19 read:

20 **“Sec. 13.** There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017,
21 from the Veterans’ Services Fund, to the Veterans’ Department of Veterans’
22 Affairs Dedicated Lottery Fund, the following amounts for the following
23 purposes:

3 dards and Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from the Crim-
4 inal Fine Account, the following amounts for the following purposes:

12 Account established under ORS 1.178, for the biennium beginning July 1,
13 2017, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for the fol-
14 lowing purposes:

23 der ORS 327.008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from the Oregon
24 Marijuana Account, the amount of \$80,987,200.

25 “(2) There is allocated to the [*Mental Health Alcoholism and Drug Ser-*
26 *vices Account established under ORS 430.380*] **Oregon Health Authority**, for
27 the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from the Oregon Marijuana Account,
28 the amount of \$40,493,600, **for:**

29 “**(a) Deposit in the Mental Health Alcoholism and Drug Services**
30 **Account established under ORS 430.380; or**

1 **“(b) Purposes related to mental health treatment and alcohol and**
2 **drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment.**

3 “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the health
4 systems division, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from the Oregon
5 Marijuana Account, the amount of \$10,123,400 for purposes related to alcohol
6 and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment services.

7 “(4) There is allocated to the State Police Account established under ORS
8 181A.020, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, from the Oregon
9 Marijuana Account, the amount of \$30,370,200.

10 **“SECTION 11. This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate**
11 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
12 **declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
