**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4018**

1 On page 6 of the printed bill, after line 38, insert:

2 **“SECTION 5. (1) The Task Force on Sustainable Funding for Ser-**
3 **VICES Provided by Coordinated Care Organizations is established.**

4 **“(2) The task force consists of:**

5 **“(a) Eight voting members appointed as follows:**

6 **“(A) Two members of the majority party in the Senate appointed**
7 **by the President of the Senate;**

8 **“(B) Two members of the minority party in the Senate appointed**
9 **by the leader of the minority party in the Senate;**

10 **“(C) Two members of the majority party in the House of Represen-**
11 **tatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and**

12 **“(D) Two members of the minority party in the House of Repre-**
13 **sentatives appointed by the leader of the minority party in the House**
14 **of Representatives; and**

15 **“(b) The following nonvoting members:**

16 **“(A) The Director of the Oregon Health Authority or an appointee**
17 **of the director who is an employee of the Oregon Health Authority;**

18 **“(B) The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business**
19 **Services or an appointee of the director who is an employee of the**
20 **Department of Consumer and Business Services;**

21 **“(C) The Director of the Department of Revenue or an appointee**

1 of the director who is an employee of the Department of Revenue;

2 “(D) One member, appointed by the Governor, from a union repre-
3 senting employees who are engaged in public health activities; and

4 “(E) Four members, appointed by the Governor, who are licensed
5 as or employed by any of the following health care provider types that
6 are licensed or certified in Oregon:

7 “(i) Inpatient hospital services providers.

8 “(ii) Outpatient hospital services providers.

9 “(iii) Nursing facilities.

10 “(iv) Intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual
11 disabilities.

12 “(v) Physicians.

13 “(vi) Home health care service providers.

14 “(vii) Providers of prescription drugs.

15 “(viii) Managed care organizations.

16 “(ix) Ambulatory surgical centers.

17 “(x) Dental service providers.

18 “(xi) Podiatrists.

19 “(xii) Chiropractic physicians.

20 “(xiii) Providers of optometric or optician services.

21 “(xiv) Psychologists.

22 “(xv) Therapists.

23 “(xvi) Nurses.

24 “(xvii) Laboratory and medical imaging service providers.

25 “(xviii) Emergency ambulance service providers.

26 “(3) The task force shall meet at least twice monthly to create a
27 legislative concept that will ensure a stable funding source or strategy
28 to pay the costs of services provided by coordinated care organizations
29 to medical assistance recipients. The task force shall present the
30 concept to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related

1 to health no later than December 31, 2018.

2 “(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes
3 a quorum for the transaction of business.

4 “(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a
5 majority of the voting members of the task force.

6 “(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as
7 chairperson.

8 “(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority
9 shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.

10 “(8) The task force shall meet at places specified by the chairperson
11 or by a majority of the voting members of the task force.

12 “(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of
13 the task force.

14 “(10) The Oregon Health Authority shall provide staff support to the
15 task force.

16 “(11) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-
17 islative Assembly or a state agency are entitled to compensation and
18 reimbursement as provided in ORS 292.495.

19 “(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,
20 are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the task
21 force’s duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to
22 confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the
23 task force consider necessary to perform their duties.

24 “SECTION 6. Section 5 of this 2018 Act is repealed on December 31,
25 2019.”.

26 In line 39, delete “5” and insert “7”.

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
