Both of you have important leadership roles in RTC & Metro Council respectively. On Friday, October 25th, the OR & WA Legislators will have a meeting to organize and hold hearings. They will lead a 10:00 to 11:30 AM field trip to the Interstate Bridge. The afternoon session will start at 1:30 PM at City Hall in Vancouver, WA. Both OR & WA Legislators have been unable to agree on "How to remodel the Interstate Bridge." (Agenda Attached)

Both RTC and Metro Council have vested interests in County Growth Plans (Clackamas, Clark, Multnomah & Washington) and in our congested traffic issue. RTC and Metro Council could lead an Interstate Bridge Task Force by bringing together the current "Four Counties' Growth Plans". Then RTC

could update their 2008 Transportation Plan at the same time. Simultaneously, Metro Council could prepare the same Traffic Corridor diagram for the three Oregon counties. Since Shirley Craddick, Metro Council is already a RTC member which would eleminate jurisdiction barriers. This suggested approach might mitigate the "Political Barriers"?
