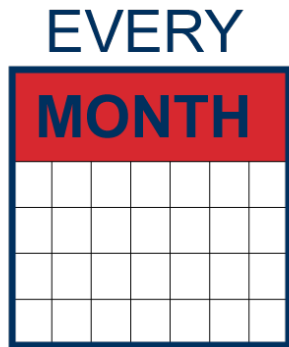

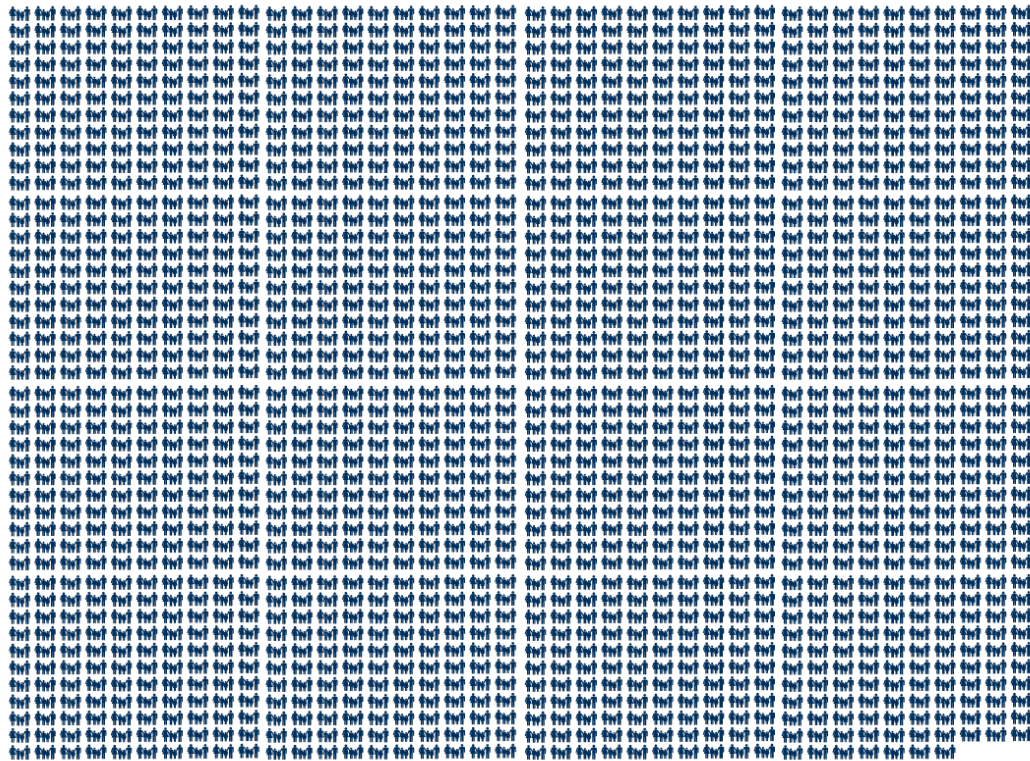

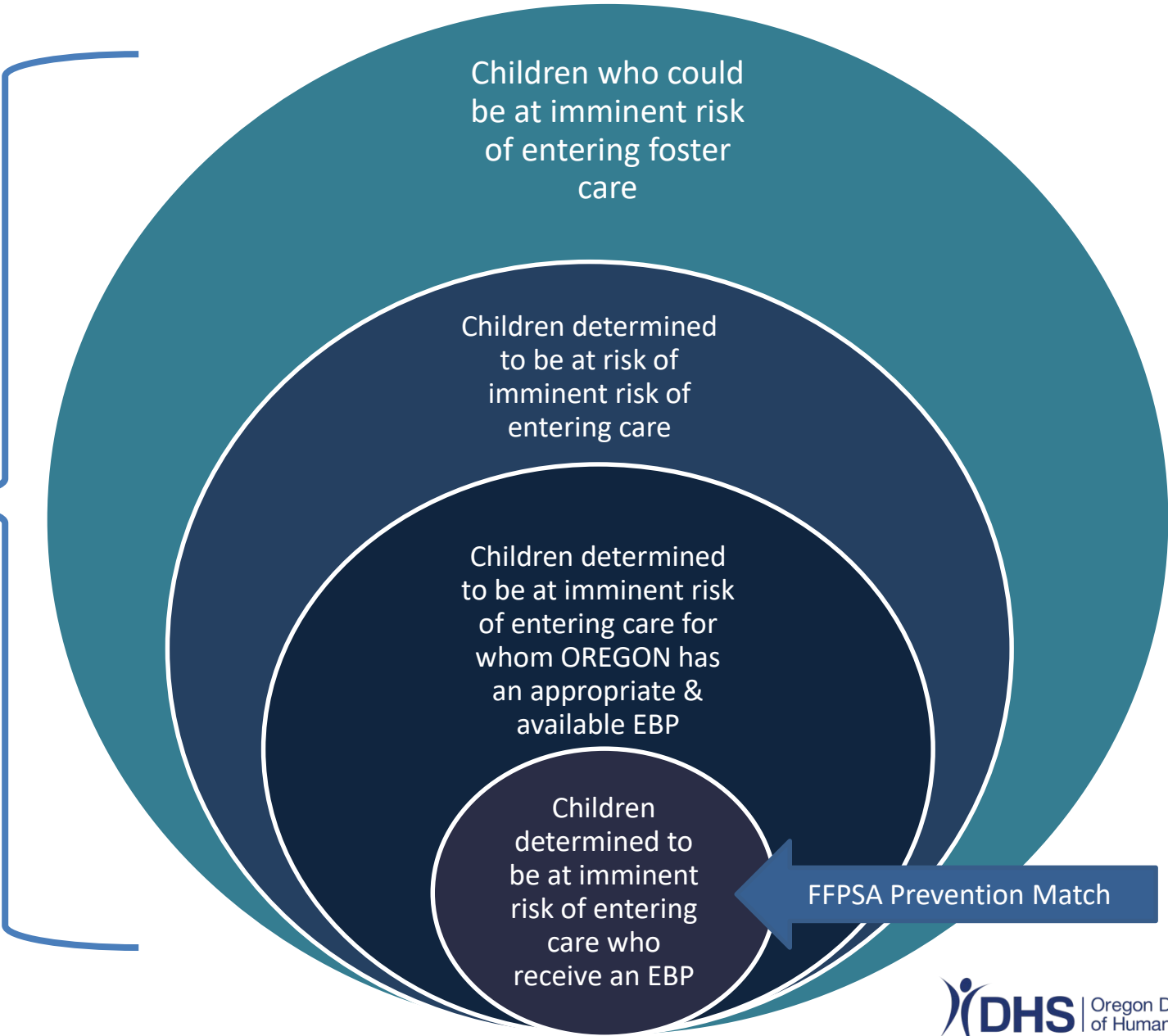

Impact of Continued Investments
