



SSA IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE



PROGRESS — BUILDING INTERNAL CAPACITY

- 1 hired (Director of Early Learning Programs)
- 4 in hiring process (Grant Specialist)
- 3 in recruitment
 - Equity Fund Program Manager
 - Research Assistant
 - Performance and Quality Specialist
- 4 begin in July 2020



EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION SECTOR PLANS

- Completed by all 16 Early Learning Hubs
- Engaged families across their regions
- Completed in tandem with a stewardship group
- Set priority populations and geographies for early care and education enrollment



SLOT DISTRIBUTION

In order to create equitable distribution of current slots, ELD has created ranges of slots by EL Hub Region based on existing Preschool Promise slots and the number of eligible children by county.


