#### SUMMARY

Commemorates centennial of town of Rhododendron.

### CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Whereas in 1846 Sam Barlow established the Barlow Road along modern-3 day United States Route 26 as an overland alternative to the treacherous 4 Columbia River portion of the Oregon Trail; and

5 Whereas weary travelers along the Barlow Road once stopped at a wide 6 spot in the road at the western foot of Mount Hood to gather strength for 7 the last stretch of their trip to the Willamette Valley; and

8 Whereas in 1905, former Portland Mayor Henry S. Rowe directed the 9 construction of and operated an inn on his parcel of land at that wide spot 10 in the road, naming it the Rhododendron Inn due to the large number of 11 rhododendrons growing in the area; and

Whereas the community of Rhododendron developed around the inn as a summer resort colony for travelers wishing to enjoy the mountain and forest scenery, as well as to ski and engage in other recreational activities; and

15 Whereas on January 26, 1920, a United States post office was dedicated 16 for the area, formally naming it Rhododendron, Oregon; and

Whereas the Rhododendron Post Office is still in operation today; and Whereas the vibrant and idyllic unincorporated town of Rhododendron remains an important part of the mountain communities of Clackamas County, and it is home to nearly 2,000 Oregonians; now, therefore,
