LC 255 2020 Regular Session 1/13/20 (RLM/ps)

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SUMMARY

Requires Housing and Community Services Department to study long-term rent assistance and to report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than October 1, 2020.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. (1) The Housing and Community Services Department
- 5 shall conduct a study on the costs and benefits of providing long-term
 - rental assistance to Oregonians who, due to severe rent burden, are
 - experiencing homelessness or are at risk of homelessness.
- 8 (2) The study must include estimates of costs of providing long-term
- 9 rental assistance across different geographic regions and to serve dif
 - ferent populations, including households with:
 - (a) Children five years of age or younger;
- 12 (b) Children at least six years of age and not older than 17 years 13 of age;
- (c) Unaccompanied homeless youths, as defined in ORS 343.035;
- 15 (d) Wards who have aged out of permanent foster care, shelter care 16 or substitute care, as defined in ORS 419A.004;
- 17 (e) Individuals who have been victims of domestic violence, as de-18 fined in ORS 135.230, 181A.355 or 411.117, or who are at risk of domestic 19 violence;
 - (f) Seniors and persons with disabilities; and

1 (g) Veterans.

- (3) The study must include an exploration of opportunities for administrative efficiencies that can be gained by looking at best practices, including local, state and federal long-term rental assistance programs and by consulting with urban and rural local housing authorities, as defined in ORS 456.375.
- (4) No later than October 1, 2020, the department shall provide a report on the findings of the study to an appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245.
- SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$125,000, to conduct the study required under section 1 of this 2020 Act.
- SECTION 3. This 2020 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 Act takes effect on its passage.
