**LC 254** appropriates \$2.5 million to the Department of Human Services for services provided to unaccompanied homeless youth. Declares an emergency, effective upon passage.

**LC 255** appropriates \$125,000 to the Department of Housing and Community Services to conduct a study on the costs and benefits of providing long-term rental assistance to those who are homeless or are at risk of being homeless due to a severe rent burden. The study must include cost estimates for long-term rental assistance for the following populations: children 5 years of age or younger; children between the ages of 6 and 17; wards as defined in [ORS 419A.004](#); domestic violence victims; seniors and persons with disabilities; and veterans. The report is due to the Legislative Assembly no later than October 1, 2020.

**LC 275** directs the Judicial Department to establish a Family Treatment Court Program in Coos, Clackamas, Douglas, Jackson and Marion Counties and appropriates an unstated amount of funds to the Judicial Department, the Department of Human Services, and the Public Defense Services Commission, to address the comprehensive needs of children, parents and family members through an integrated, collaborative, court-based program. Directs the state court administrator to meet certain requirements for the program. Requires biennial reports to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to child welfare no later than September 15 of each even-numbered year. Declares an emergency. Effective upon passage.
