SUMMARY

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on how Oregon's community colleges and public universities can best combat food and housing insecurity among their students.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to needs of students at post-secondary institutions of education; and

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission 6 shall conduct a study on the prevalence of food and housing insecurity 7 for students attending a community college in Oregon or a public 8 university listed in ORS 352.002.

9 (2)(a) In conducting the study required by this section, the com-10 mission shall solicit data from each community college in Oregon and 11 public university listed in ORS 352.002 on:

(A) How the community college or public university measures food
 and housing insecurity among its student population; and

(B) The level of food and housing insecurity among students en rolled at the community college or public university.

(b) Each community college and public university shall promptly
 provide the commission with all information requested under this
 subsection.

mission, shall submit, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, a report
to the interim legislative committees responsible for higher education
no later than December 15, 2020. The report shall:

4 (a) Compile in an aggregate and easy to understand format the in5 formation provided by community colleges and public universities un6 der this section;

7 (b) Compare the information provided by community colleges and 8 public universities with national trends and best practices on food and 9 housing insecurity among students enrolled at post-secondary insti-10 tutions of education, including data related to the cost of attending 11 post-secondary institutions of education;

(c) Identify potential gaps in how community colleges and public
 universities are addressing food and housing insecurity among their
 students; and

(d) Include recommendations for new policies, including budgetary
 increases, that could be adopted to better combat food and housing
 insecurity among students enrolled at community colleges and public
 universities.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2020 Act is repealed on December 31,
 20 2021.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2020 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 Act takes effect on its passage.
